



Multi-factor Authentication (MFA)

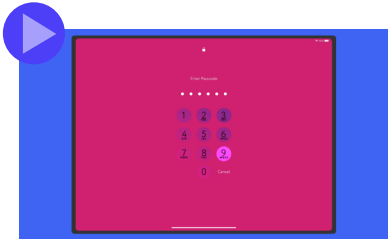
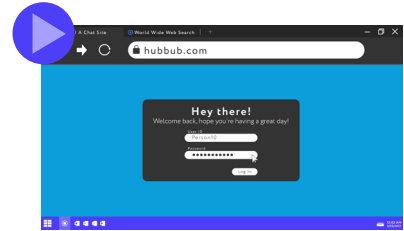

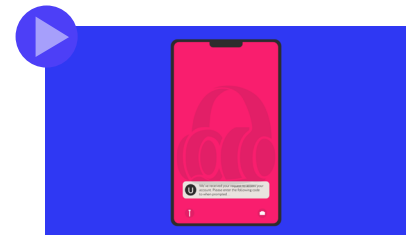
1. What is multi-factor authentication?
